

The bonsai root formation (nebari) is another part of the tree which shows age. The rules suggest that it has to radiate outward, and has to be

large above the soil and then turn into fine roots as it goes to the ground. The bonsai roots show stability strength and age.

Figure 1 - Structural bonsai roots radiating outwards

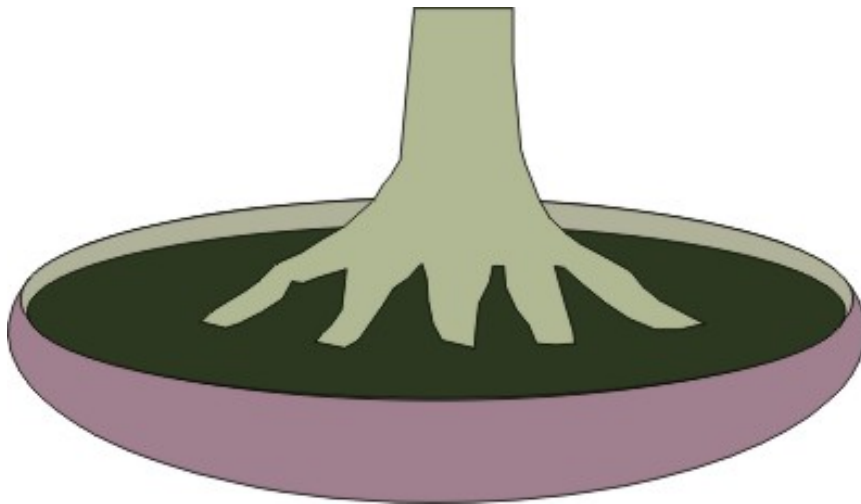


Figure 2 - The large structural bonsai roots turn into fine roots just after it enters the soil.
